We will start the day with a comprehensive and interesting theory about driving dynamics and continue by real driving on ice to learn the secrets of the professionals. You will drive with the ice racing tyres studded with very long spikes, experience the spinning wheels sending pieces of ice flying just like a rally car throws rocks and dirt in summer. You will test the limits of the car and your own skills and certainly learn new tricks. There will be a fight against the clock to become the Speed Hero of that vast lake area.

The Master of the events will be **Tino Aaltonen**, who became famous as the fastest saloon car racer in Finland and was running his own very successful racing team as well in Finland, Germany and Sweden. He also has a long time experience in training both racing and rally drivers, twenty years improving good people from one-to-one sessions to larger groups and manufacturer organized trainings. His remarkable results with his students are well known. He has been working for several years for example Mini, BMW, Porsche and Ferrari international manufactures and importers all over the world.

The Aaltonen School is based on the unique training methods of Tino's father **Rauno Aaltonen**, the Rally Legend, known all over the world with the nickname "Professor". He was the founder of the BMW Driver Training and he made the Mini Cooper famous by winning the Rallye Monte Carlo and by driving in the untouchable BMC Mini Rally Team. Since then he has competed in rallies and on racing circuits in nearly anything on four wheels in incredible 127 different countries.

- The cancellation** The confirmation fee will be charged as the cancellation fee. If the cancellation is four weeks before the event or later, the total price will be charged.
- When** The best conditions for a winter event are in February and March. Thick ice, white snow and shining sun with clear sky subject to weather.
